Who is a displaced homemaker?

NC General Statute 143B-394.4

defines a displaced homemaker as an individual who meets all three of the following criteria:

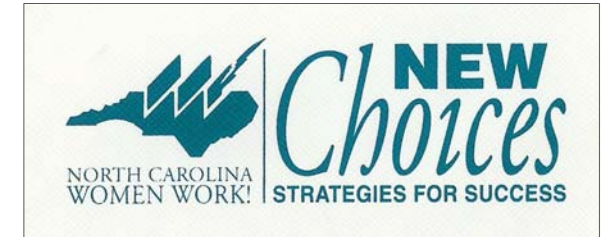
1. Has worked in his or her own household and had provided unpaid household services; and
2. Is unable to secure gainful employment due to lack of required training, age, or experience; or is unemployed or under employed; and
3. Has been dependent on the income of another household member but is no longer adequately supported by that income, or is receiving support but within two years of losing the support, or has been supported by public assistance as the parent of minor children and is no longer eligible, or within two years of losing the eligibility.

Requirements for recipients

Recipients of the Displaced Homemaker grant have several requirements to fulfill.

1. All recipients are expected to attend mandatory workshops.
2. All recipients are required to attend monthly counseling sessions with the New Choices Coordinator.
3. Each semester, curriculum students must turn in a copy of their transcripts.
4. Each semester, Continuing Education students are required to turn in a copy of their certificate of completion.
